Day 1 – Read I Corinthians 1 & 2

Date Read _____

Corinth was a major seaport city filled with every kind of sin from idol worship to immorality. The Corinthian Church was struggling because as Christians they were so different now than the non-Christian people. They felt the pressure to “fit in” but they knew they were called to live differently. Paul heard of their struggles and wrote this letter to address their problems, heal their divisions, and answer their questions. 1Corinthians calls all Christians to be careful not to blend in with the world and accept its values and life-styles. As you read this letter to the Corinthian Church examine your values and your complete commitment to Christ. Enjoy!

Day 2 – Read I Corinthians 3 & 4

Date Read _____

1. How do we know that we are living for Christ and not like the people of the world?
2. How can we continue to live for Christ?

Day 3 – Read I Corinthians 5

Date Read _____

1. Paul is very serious about the Corinthian Church dealing with a man who is sinning and doesn't want to change. Is this man a Christian? (Hint: verses 9-11)
2. What is Paul telling the church to do with this man and why?

Day 4 – Read I Corinthians 6

Date Read _____

1. If we have an issue with another believer what is Paul telling us to do?
2. In verses 12-13 What do you think Paul means when he says that we are allowed to do anything but we must not become a slave to anything?

Day 5 – Read I Corinthians 7

Date Read _____

1. One of Paul's main points to this chapter is in verses 29-31. What is this point?
2. What does Paul want us to focus our lives on?

Day 1 – Read I Corinthians 8 & 9

Date Read _____

1. Knowledge can make us look good and feel important, but we can develop an arrogant, know-it-all attitude. Many people with strong opinions are unwilling to listen to and learn from God and others. Write down one thing that God has taught you recently that was new to you.
2. Paul is all about witnessing, telling others about what Christ has done for them. In I Cor. 9:19-22 Paul lists a few things that he tries to do to maybe open up a door to share the gospel. When Paul says, “to the Jews I became like a Jew” he is finding a common ground with them. At school you may talk to someone and find out you are both in the band. It gives you a common interest to talk about that may lead to sharing your faith. What do you think Paul mean when he said, “to the weak I become weak”?

Day 2 – Read I Corinthians 10 & 11

Date Read _____

1. Something you may not know: A lot of meat bought in the marketplace was first offered to an idol or god in one of the many pagan temples. Some of the new Christians in Corinth wondered if they ate this meat were they somehow participating in the worship of pagan idols. How did Paul answer this?
2. Paul confronts the problems the Corinthian people were having in worship (I Cor. 11:3-16) and during the Lord's Supper (I Cor. 11:17-34). Paul sums up the answer for each of these problems in I Cor. 10:31 & 32. What does he say?

Day 3 – Read I Corinthians 12 & 13

Date Read _____

1. God has given each of us a Spiritual Gift or Gifts that are to be used to build up, serve and strengthen other Christians. One thing must be in our hearts when we use our spiritual gifts. What is that one thing that must be present whenever we use a spiritual gift?

Day 4 – Read I Corinthians 14 - 15:1-34

Date Read _____

1. In Chp. 14 Paul continues to address some of the issues that the Corinthian believers were having with Spiritual gifts & worship. But, then in 15:1-4, he brings them back to the main point, the gospel. Simply, what is the gospel?
2. What does Chp. 15:10a say?

*Let the thankfulness that you have - for God's amazing grace in your life - allow you to live totally for Him.

Day 5 – Read I Corinthians 15:35 - 16

Day 1 – Read II Corinthians 1 & 2

Date Read _____

1. When life is easy we can easily depend on our own skills and abilities. It may be only when life gets hard that we cry out to God for help. God wants us to depend on Him all the time. Depending on God everyday is realizing our own powerlessness without Him and our need for His constant touch in our lives. This is what the word "Humble" means. List some ways that you rely on Him every day (if you don't – list some ways that you could and then try this week to do at least one of them each day). Re-read II Cor. 1:9-10.
2. If a person has done something wrong, is punished, and has repented (will not do it again) we need to forgive that person, encourage him and help him to not do it again. Christ commands us to forgive as He has forgiven us. Write down a time when you were really sorry for something you did to someone and they forgave you. Remember to always do the same for someone who sins against you – Have Mercy!

Day 2 – Read II Corinthians 3 & 4

Date Read _____

1. What's Paul talking about? In II Cor. 3:7-18 what is the Ministry that brought death and condemns? (Hint: Exodus 20)
2. What is the ministry of the Spirit that brings righteousness?
3. What is Paul referring to in vs.13 that the radiance was fading? (Hint: Exodus 34:29-35)
4. Re-read II Cor. 3:7-18. Does it make more sense now - if it didn't at first?

Day 3 – Read II Corinthians 5

Date Read _____

1. What's the definition of Reconciled/Reconciliation? (Look it up if you have to) Re-read II Cor. 5:11-21.
2. Paul says in verse 20 – We implore (urge/beg) you on Christ's behalf! Be reconciled to God. Re-read II Cor. 9-10. If you follow Paul's advice to be reconciled to God, how will you feel when you appear before the judgment seat of Christ?

Day 4 – Read II Corinthians 6

Date Read _____

1. God does not expect us to live a righteous life on our own. On our own we will fail. He wants us to depend on Him and His power that He gives to us! He has power that we must use because we are fighting a spiritual battle. In verse 7 what are the weapons of righteousness for our right hand and our left hand that God gives us to fight with? (Hints: Romans 13:1-2, II Cor. 10:3-5, Ephesians 6:10-18) You can use more paper if you need to.

*Cool Thought – Weapons for the right hand are offensive (unless you're left-handed). Weapons for the other hand are defensive. We need both offensive and defensive weapons to be prepared for battle!

Day 5 – Read II Corinthians 7

Date Read _____

Paul had to correct the Corinthian people because they were confused and sinning. It was hard for him to do this because he knew it would hurt them. But he did it because he loved them and wanted them to see their mistakes and be able to change. They accepted the fact that they were wrong and were very full of sorrow. They didn't let that sorrow stop them though they repented, accepted God's forgiveness, changed their ways (which can be the hard one!) and were full of joy! If someone corrects you because you are sinning, let yourself be sorry and grieve your sin but don't let it paralyze you! Accept God's forgiveness, change using God's power and be full of joy!

Day 1 – Read II Corinthians 8 & 9 Date Read _____

1. Paul spends these 2 chapters telling the Corinthian church to make sure they have their gift ready when he gets there. Why?
2. Paul knows that these people in Corinth want to give to the people in Jerusalem but Paul wants to make sure they are giving with the right attitude. What attitude does Paul say we need to have when giving to others?

Day 2 – Read II Corinthians 10 Date Read _____

1. God has given you the opportunity to share your faith with others that don't know Christ and now He is giving you the opportunity to share your story in Nitelife. Does this scare you? Why?
2. Are you afraid that you won't be able to speak well?
3. In this chapter, some people were saying that Paul was not a good speaker. Read Exodus 4:10-12 and Jeremiah 1:6-8. Both Moses and Jeremiah were not confident in their speaking abilities either. But God used all 3 of these guys to accomplish His work. What can we learn from them that we can use in our own lives as we try to conquer our fears to speak boldly for Christ?

Day 3 – Read II Corinthians 11 Date Read _____

1. The people of Corinth had many false teachers and preachers trying to get them to believe lies about Christ and the gospel message (that Christ was God's son, died, was buried and rose again for our sins). In this Chapter Paul is pleading for the people to believe what he has taught them and turn away from the false teachers. Just as Eve lost her focus in the garden and listened to Satan, the serpent, and ate the fruit; we too can be distracted and confused in our walk with God. Is there anything in your life right now that is making you lose your focus on God?
2. How can you minimize or get rid of this distraction that threatens your devotion to Him?

Day 4 – Read II Corinthians 12 Date Read _____

1. Not only was Paul concerned with the people following false teaching but he was very concerned about some in the church that were still sinning. Paul is basically saying, "Don't make me discipline you when I get there!!" This was going to be his 3rd visit to Corinth. What were some of the sins that Paul wanted them to stop doing before he visited them?

Day 5 – Read II Corinthians 13 Date Read _____

1. God has put Godly people in your life to help you mature in your faith just as He put Paul in the lives of the people of the Corinthian church. In verse 10 Paul explains that he wants them to stop sinning so that when he comes he can build them up and teach them more and not have to tear them down. Sometimes the Godly people in our lives, parents, small group leaders, etc. have to confront us with sin in our lives. They are showing you your sin because they love you and want to see you grow in your faith!

Day 1 – Read Galatians 1

Date Read _____

1. Who wrote this letter? _____ To whom? _____
2. Paul begins his letter with the Gospel Message. What is that?
3. The Gospel Message, the Good News that Paul was telling the people of Galatia was that Jesus died for our sins. Jesus paid the price. There is nothing more we need to do to be saved except to accept His free gift. In Galatia, the Jews were telling them that they had to believe in Jesus AND become Jewish to be saved. Do you remember what really bad thing Paul was doing before he became a Christian? (Hint: Acts 6:8-7:60) (remember Paul was called Saul back then)
4. What did God do to Paul that showed Paul that Jesus was His son and the Savior of the world? (Hint: Acts 9:1-22)

Day 2 – Read Galatians 2

Date Read _____

1. Paul continues trying to make sure that everyone understands what he is preaching. (Day 1). Who does he meet with to make sure that they understand and agree with him?
2. Do they agree that Paul should continue preaching to the Gentiles (everybody that is not a Jew) and that he should continue telling them that they do not have to become Jewish to be saved? _____
3. What was Paul's issue with Peter? (Acts 2:11-21)

Day 3 – Read Galatians 3

Date Read _____

1. It is easy for us to become like the Galatians people. We start thinking when we sin, "I'll do better next time" or "I'll never do that again". This kind of thinking usually ends in failure. We, by ourselves can't break this cycle of sin. What hope do we have to overcome sins that we repeatedly do? What power do we receive when we allow Jesus to be Lord of our lives? (Gal. 3:1-5 & 3:13-14)
2. Do we have freedom from the bondage of sin by obeying God's laws or by faith that Christ took the punishment for our sins on the cross?

Day 4 – Read Galatians 4

Date Read _____

1. We are free to Live for Christ! We have all the power through the Holy Spirit to do this! Write out I Cor. 10:13.
2. Memorize it. Spend some time in prayer. Ask God to help you the next time you are tempted. Ask Him to give you the power and perseverance to not sin. He will provide that way out if you look for it!

Day 5 – Read Galatians 5 & 6

Date Read _____

1. What specifically are we free to do? (Gal. 5:13)
2. What does the Holy Spirit give us? (Gal 5:17)
3. What does the Holy Spirit produce in our lives? (Gal. 5:22)
4. Re-read Gal. 6:11-18. Paul wants us to get it! We are a new creation in Christ Jesus! He has freed us from the bondage of sin. Draw Steve's hand motion for "freedom from sin".
