Discussion Points

- Read through Proverbs 7 out loud a couple of times as a small group. What warnings and admonitions do you hear? How does this text apply to you personally? Discuss your answers together. What can you learn from each other as you strive to be sexually pure?
- Many questions from people in the congregation were placed up on the screen while the panel discussed this vital topic of sexual purity. Were there any questions that you sent or wanted answered? If so, bring them up to your group and prayerfully discuss them together.
- What was said by the panel that was helpful to you? Please explain.
- Reflect on the handout by Don Miller (at the information desk)- “How to Live a Great Love Story.”
